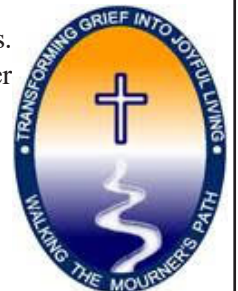


## Walking the Mourner's Path ...

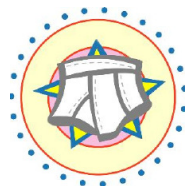
