**CELTIC KIRK** 5:00 p.m.

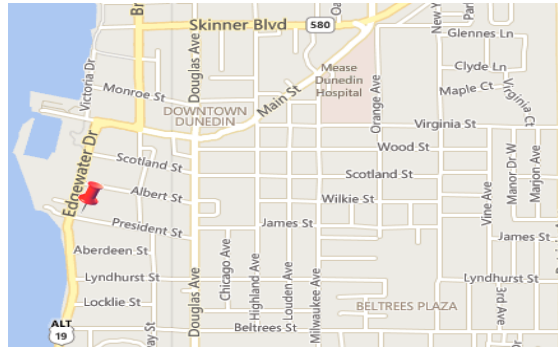
