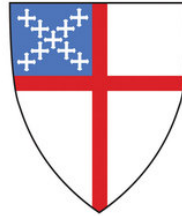

December 9.

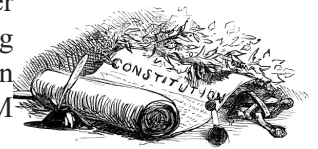


Teens will gather separately with Carey Cherivtch, our Christian Education Director, on dates and times best for the youth.

5:00 p.m. Holy Eucharist with Bishop Curry

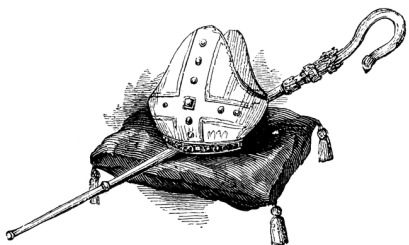
