# Caladesi Memories Saturday • Aug. 4th • 10:30 AM

The focus of Caladesi Memories is Myrtle Scharrer Betz who, at age 87, authored "Yesteryear I Lived in Paradise: The Story of Caladesi Island." Myrtle was the only child ever born on Caladesi Island, located across St. Joseph Sound from the Church of the Good Shepherd. Her memoir communicates the joys and travails of Florida pioneers. Myrtle's granddaughter, Terry Fortner, will share stories accompanied with historic photos of the Scharrer Homestead. The latest printing was in 2009 and includes Myrtle's original work plus an updated timeline. Proceeds from the book support projects at Caladesi Island State Parks.
