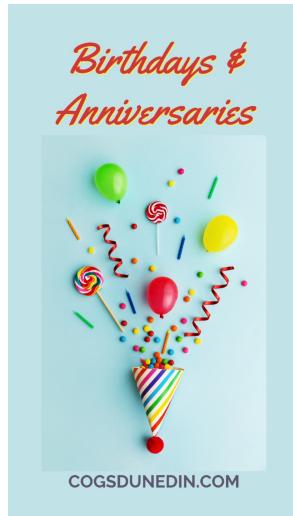
Summer Sermon Series:
