

It's a process by which our parish will consider our relationships with Jesus and one another, individually and collectively. We will look at what we're doing that helps that growth, and where we have growth opportunity.


How does RenewalWorks work?

It begins with an online, confidential, anonymous survey taken by as many parishioners as possible between Jan 27th and Feb 17th. Those answers will create a snapshot of our congregation, useful data for deciding what's next.
