What is RenewalWorks?

It's a process by which our parish will consider our relationships with Jesus and one another, individually and collectively. We will look at what we're doing that helps that growth, and where we have growth opportunity.

How does RenewalWorks work?

It begins with an online, confidential, anonymous survey taken by as many parishioners as possible by Feb 17th. This inventory, which takes about a half hour, asks about your spiritual journey, how the church, how personal spiritual practices, how service figures into that journey. Those answers will create a snapshot of our congregation, data we'll use during workshops to decide what's next.
