Transfiguration Sunday, March 3

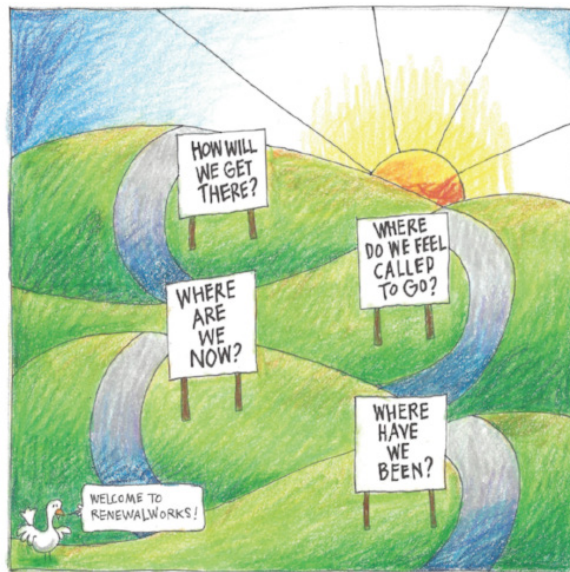
