Cross Walk

For more than 10 years, a small but prayerful group has gathered for a Cross Walk starting at noon on Good Friday. Beginning where the Pinellas Trail crosses Albert St., we walk through downtown Dunedin, stopping at various places for the traditional 14 Stations of the Cross, and ending in the nave of Good Shepherd for final prayers and a time for meditation.

We take turns carrying a large wooden cross and the laypeople take the lead in reading the scripture verses, meditations, and prayers. Although we get plenty of quizzical looks, we also receive several expressions of thanks, and sometimes passersby will join in.

This is an ecumenical event suitable for all Christians. We welcome any and all to join us. There is no need to sign up, just show up shortly before noon on the Trail at Albert St.

People may park at the church. Service booklets will be available.
