Congratulations to Maureen Belote — The Canon Joyce Hogg Award Recipient, Diocese of Southwest Florida

Maureen Belote has faithfully served the Diocese of Southwest Florida as Diocesan Coordinator since 1996 when she was appointed by Bishop Rogers Sanders Harris. She became attached to the organization as a child when she was given a mite box in Sunday School and told that the coins collected would help children in a place called Haiti. Of course, at that time Episcopal Relief & Development was known as the Presiding Bishop's Fund for World Relief.

As an adult living in New Jersey, Maureen became more fully vested in the organization's work. For several years during the mid 1980's and beyond, Maureen and other members of St. Paul's in Morris Plains would stage musical performances to support the Presiding Bishop's Fund. Her favorite role was that of the Wicked Witch of the West. Over \$1,000 were raised from producing The Wizard of Oz. St. Paul's rector at the time, the Rev. David Hamilton, was also the Diocesan Coordinator for the Presiding Bishop's Fund. Upon moving to Dunedin, FL, Maureen was surprised that no effort for The Presiding Bishop's Fund was evident in her new parish. Working with the Rector, Maureen invited guests to give homilies to raise awareness, including former Public Relations Director for the Presiding Bishop's Fund Katerina Whitley, and Maureen's former rector Fr. Dave Hamilton. As a result, Maureen's commitment grew into volunteer work for the diocese then her appointment as Diocesan Coordinator. During her tenure, Maureen has had three co-coordinators, the most recent being Jody Tiffany who was appointed in 2000.

Good Shepherd Readies for Hurricane Season



In September 2017 the Church of the Good Shepherd was visited by Hurricane Irma. We were very fortunate that this was a relatively low category hurricane and the parish experienced only minor damage and inconvenience. Thanks to careful planning the impact of Hurricane Irma was minimal. In June hurricane season will

begin again and run through the end of November, and Good Shepherd is prepared in case we are hit by another storm. The parish has an Emergency Plan to cover a wide variety of emergencies and disasters and is available in the church office for your reading. We also have an Emergency Management Team that is ready to step into action if needed.

The Emergency Management Team encourages you to have a plan for your safety should we have a storm this hurricane season. This includes the stockpiling of supplies for your family and a plan for evacuation if implemented by the county. It is very important that you are prepared and that you follow all directives by county officials. The Church of Good Shepherd has a Disaster Support Network. If you have not filled out your Hurricane Information Sheet please pick one up at any worship service, complete it and return it to Jan Cote or Michelle Schombs. This form will give us information to keep in touch before and after a storm in our area. We also want parishioners to know that we have an ice machine and all effort will be made to bag ice prior to a storm and after a storm if power and water are available. The parish has two generators which can be used to power the ice machine and other small electronics.
