## **Financial Information!**

Charitable donations made directly from a traditional IRA can save taxes. People 70<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> and older can transfer up to \$100,000 yearly from IRAs directly to charity. Qualified charitable distributions [QCDs] can count as required minimum distributions, but they are not taxable and they are not added to your adjusted gross income.

*Here's a tip:* The money must go directly to a charitable organization. Transfers to a donor-advised fund, charitable gift annuity, charitable remainder trust and any other life-income or split-interest gift arrangement aren't treated as QCDs.
