Update on the Search for a New Rector

Step by Step into the Future

We know where we're going, and we have turn-by-turn directions for getting there. There are certain milestones along the way to calling a new Rector for this wonderful church.

Here's where we are on the road:

Milestone #1: Self Study - The Self-Study Survey explores the kind of priest this church family wants to call as the next Rector at Good Shepherd. The survey was distributed on July 19th via email to those who have registered to receive Constant Contact messages. Paper copies are also available at the church, and you can request that be sent to through regular mail by calling the office. Please complete this important survey by July 31st.

Milestone #2: Sunday Services - "What about Sundays, after Pastor Becky is gone?" The Vestry is working with our Diocesan Transition Officer to find priests to lead worship beginning on Sept 6th

Milestone #3: Search Committee - The Vestry will appoint a Search Committee to do the exciting work of assessing the priests who apply to become our next Rector. Next week, people interested on serving on the Search Committee will be invited to complete an application, which will have the complete expectations and requirements to serve. From among those who apply, the Vestry will select a Committee Chair; together, they will identify 7-9 more members representing as diverse a group as possible (age, gender, ethnicity, length of membership, skills, experience, etc.). The Chairperson will work closely the Diocesan Transition Officer and our Senior Warden, Phil Beauchamp.

Milestone #4: Beginning the Search - The search officially goes 'live' when Pastor Becky retires. The position opening will be disseminated through the Office of Transition Ministry onto a variety of local, regional and national websites and networks.

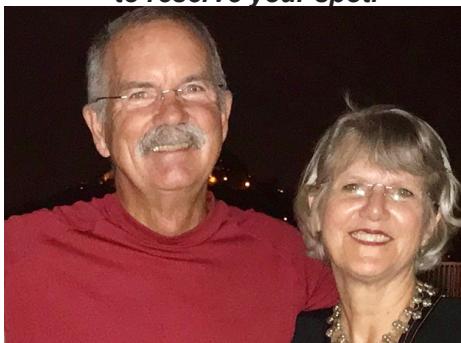
