### **GUIDELINES FROM THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH**

#### DON'T PANIC. BE SMART.

- WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN with soap and water for 20 seconds the length of The Lord's Prayer. It's longer than you think.
- USE HAND SANITIZER after touching another person, door knobs, phones, keyboards, handrails, or anything you don't know where it's been.
- DON'T TOUCH OTHERS IN PUBLIC including the sharing of the Peace: smile, wave, bow, bump elbows . . . hugs and handshakes can wait for now.
- COUGH AND SNEEZE INTO YOUR ELBOW or use a tissue and throw it away immediately. Wash your hands or use sanitizer right away.

#### + OPTIONS FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION

- Receive as usual; drinking from a precious metal chalice with proper use of the purificator is a low risk. Our mouths are cleaner than our hands.
- Receive the bread only; cross your arms and reverence the chalice but don't drink from it.
- Do NOT dip the bread in the chalice; our hands are prime germ carriers. Like hugging, intincting (dipping) can wait for now.
- + STAY HOME IF YOU FEEL ILL! You can participate remotely by watching our 10 AM Sunday service online at COGSDunedin.com.
