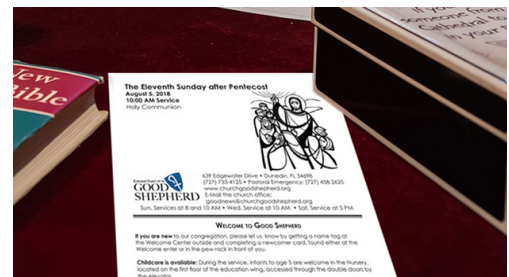


Sunday Worship Bulletins are Online!

GUIDELINES FROM THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH

DON'T PANIC. BE SMART.

- ✦ **WASH YOUR HANDS OFTEN** with soap and water for 20 seconds – the length of *The Lord's Prayer*. It's longer than you think.
- ✦ **USE HAND SANITIZER** after touching another person, door knobs, phones, keyboards, handrails, or anything you don't know where it's been.
- ✦ **DON'T TOUCH OTHERS IN PUBLIC** - including the sharing of the Peace: smile, wave, bow, bump elbows . . . hugs and handshakes can wait for now.
- ✦ **COUGH AND SNEEZE INTO YOUR ELBOW** or use a tissue and throw it away immediately. Wash your hands or use sanitizer right away.
- ✦ **OPTIONS FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION**
 - **Receive as usual;** drinking from a precious metal chalice with proper use of the purificator is a low risk. Our mouths are cleaner than our hands.
 - **Receive the bread only;** cross your arms and reverence the chalice but don't drink from it.
 - **Do NOT dip the bread in the chalice;** our hands are prime germ carriers. Like hugging, intincting (dipping) can wait for now.
- ✦ **STAY HOME IF YOU FEEL ILL!** You can participate remotely by watching our 10 AM Sunday service online at COGSDunedin.com.



WHY ONE THOUSAND DAYS ARE IMPORTANT!

Nutrition, in particular, plays a foundational role in a child's development and her country's ability to prosper.
