

THE LITTLE THRIFT SHOP (LTS) NEEDS YOUR HELP

If you have driven or walked down Main Street in Dunedin in the last few months, you may have noticed that The Little Thrift Shop is no longer at 506 Main Street, where it has been located for the past 45 years. A new owner purchased the property and did not renew our lease. Many in the congregation may not be aware that the Little Thrift Shop even existed.

Why is the LTS important to the Church of the Good Shepherd?

Sponsored by the Episcopal Church Women (ECW), the Little Thrift Shop opened its doors for the first time in February 1956 on Douglas Avenue in Dunedin, Florida. Twenty years later, the shop moved to 506 Main Street where it remained until January 31, 2021. During that time, proceeds from the sale of donated goods, managed by the ECW, have generated contributions to charitable organizations for nearly 65 years. In just the past ten years, over \$142,000 has been donated to outreach, mission, and various church projects.

How can you help?

Several of you have asked if we could use space on the church campus. We submitted to the Vestry a proposal for use of the Patio Room and a task force was formed. The Vestry subsequently decided that there is not space that is feasible on the church campus. Which brings us to the present situation of seeking a new location to continue the LTS mission.

The ideal property should:

- Be between 800 and 1,000 square feet
 - Cost no more than \$1000 a month including utilities
- Have nearby parking
- Have a backdoor for donation drop off
- Ideally be located within walking distance of downtown Dunedin. (Weekend special events with a lot of foot traffic were especially profitable.)
