## Drive Thru Communion This Sunday, May 10th, 9:15 - 9:50 and 11:15-12:00



Dear Church Family,

We are thrilled to offer Holy Communion to you again this Sunday. As always, we understand that your health and safety are the very highest priority. If you are in the group that should remain at home, we completely support your decision to wait until joining us in person entails substantially less risk.

**WORSHIP COMES FIRST!** Please join us in worship online at your preferred time. The teaching of the Church is that one should hear the Gospel read and proclaimed before receiving Holy Communion. We won't begin distributing the elements for about 15 minutes after the end of the services, so there's no point in getting to the church before either 9:15 or 11:15, respectively.

**COME TO GOOD SHEPHERD SECOND** Come on foot, on a bike, or in a car - all are welcome, no exceptions! No matter how you arrive, though, please remember that we will be observing the 10+6 Rule: No more than 10 people in a room at one time, and everyone always 6 feet apart (except those of you who share a household can be closer together).

People who walk or bike to church will come into Kirk Hall to receive.

People in cars should enter the parking lot from Albert St. using the regular entrance. We will have a table with Holy Communion along the fence on the south side of the parking lot. You will not need to get out of your car to receive Holy Communion. You will receive a host in a small plastic cup; please dispose of it when you get home.

You may leave either via the driveway alongside the church to Edgewater, or turn back alongside the playground and exit onto Albert.

### **Many Hands Needed to Re-open our Church for Worship!**

We're not sure exactly when it will happen, but the bishop will at some point (soon, I hope!) permit us to re-open the sanctuary for congregational worship. The Buildings & Grounds Team wants everyone to feel and be safe when that happens. To help keep us all healthy, the church will need to be sanitized every week, wiping down the surfaces in the church that people touch, such as pew tops and door handles. This is truly a time when many hands will make light work, and it's not difficult.

In addition to this special health-related task, we need help with other routine chores, some weekly and others only periodically:

- Locking up the Campus every Sunday after the last service. This takes about 30 minutes.
- Opening up the Campus on Sundays when our Sexton is away. This takes about 15 minutes.
- Cleaning the Campus when the Sexton is on vacation. There's a lot more to this one, and it can be done over several different days.

All materials will be supplied, as will training. I don't know about you, but after not being able to be here for weeks, gathering together at church is now even more important to me.
