

Please plan on joining us at your choice of service time on Nov. 1st, in-person or via live-stream.




The Little Thrift Shop is now open on Fridays and Saturdays from 10am till 2pm. We are in need of volunteers – and will work with your schedule.

We would like to open on Thursdays; however, we need additional volunteers to fully staff three days. A minimum of two volunteers per day is required.




