Boxes for gifts are in the church Narthex and in Kirk Hall (Open 9am-4pm) Monetary gifts are especially welcome. Make checks to COGS and note Farm Workers' Account. You can also make your gifts through REALM. We will be happy to shop for you.

Because of Covid-19, we will not be bagging gifts. We will take all gifts to Resurrection House, Dade City. This year they will not have their annual Christmas Party. Instead, families will make specific requests and RH staff will fill each family's bag appropriately. At a designated time, families will drive up and be given their gifts.

All of the items listed last week are still wanted. We have been given additional requests they also need:

- Small balls for younger children
- Regular footballs and soccer balls
- New books in English (to enjoy and to improve ability to read English)
- Men's long-sleeved button up shirts S, M, L, XL (no XXL), worn at work
- Women's long-sleeved button up shirts M, L, worn at work
- All sizes underwear or socks
- Games such as Checkers, Dominoes, Uno or other card games
- Items for infants

They emphasized, NO TOY GUNS OR OTHER WEAPONS.
